Announcement No. 1

Ladies and Gentlemen,

The 11th Conference "Geoecological Problems of the Karkonosze Mountains", a bilateral Polish-Czech scientific event with more than 30-years-long tradition, will be organized in the Polish part of the Karkonosze by the Karkonosze National Park, in cooperation with the Krkonošský Narodní Park and several academic partners.

The main theme of the conference is "**Karkonosze** – **outstanding geodiversity and its implications**". Emphasizing geodiversity we want to highlight multiple values and various characteristics of the abiotic environment of the Karkonosze (geology, landforms, soils, climate, water conditions), many of which are unique on a European scale, and how they underpin biotic world, the history of human occupation and contemporary use.

By choosing the main theme and the dates of the conference we contribute to the global celebration of the World Geodiversity Day, established by UNESCO for 6 October each year and organized for the first time in 2022.

We envisage three plenary sessions, with talks addressing subjects closely related to the main theme of the conference. These are:

- Geodiversity of the Karkonosze

- Geodiversity as a factor underpinning biodiversity of the Karkonosze
- Geodiversity as a factor underpinning cultural heritage and contemporary use of

the Karkonosze

However, presentations on any subject related to the geoecology of the Karkonosze, not limited to geodiversity and its implications, are welcome and for these we envisage poster sessions, with ample time for discussions. Presentations focused on comparisons between the Karkonosze and other mountain massif, especially from the Central European Mountain Belt, are also encouraged.

Field trips scheduled for the third day of the conference will provide an opportunity for the participants to examine various abiotic features of the Karkonosze and how they influence the living world and human history.

The binding language of the Conference is English

The organizers may provide authors of presentations and posters with the opportunity to publish their works in the form of articles in three journals:

- **Opera Corcontica** - a peer-reviewed journal dealing with all aspects of research conducted in the Czech and Polish Karkonosze and high ranges of the Sudetes, publishes materials in Czech, Polish and English;

- Landform Analysis - reviewed journal of the Association of Polish Geomorphologists (IFnone, ministerial list - 70 points). A periodical in which any research material related to the concept of geodiversity can be published;

- Acta Scientiarum Polonorum Seria Silvarum Colendarum Ratio et Industria (Polish Journal of Forestry) - a peer-reviewed journal of the Poznań University of Life Sciences, publishing scientific articles from a very wide range of forest sciences (IF - none, ministerial list - 20 points).

Until March 31, 2023 - pre-application (must be sent by March 31, 2023 to <u>geoeco@kpnmab.pl</u>; **April 30, 2023** - distribution of Announcement No. 2, with the costs of the conference, detailed program and instructions for preparing a summary of the presentation;

May 31, 2023 - sending a confirmed declaration of participation and paying the conference fee; June 30, 2023 - sending abstracts of posters for further elaboration in Book of Abstracts;

Information clause regarding the handling of personal data

The administrator, i.e. the entity acting on how it will monitor your personal data, is the Karkonoski Park Narodowy with its registered office in Jelenia Góra, ul. Chałubińskiego 23, 58-570 Jelenia Góra, hereinafter referred to as KPN.

As a data controller, we guarantee the fulfillment of all rights under the General Data Protection Regulation, i.e. the right to access, rectify and delete your data, limit their processing, the right to transfer them, not to be subject to automated decision-making, as well as the right to object to the processing of your data your personal data.

With these rights, you can:

• regarding the rectification of data: when we noticed you that the data are correct or incomplete;

• to delete data when your data no longer support the purposes for which they were collected by KPN;

• if you withdraw your consent to data processing, when the effect will be taken into account in relation to the processing of your data;

• in order to comply with the obligation to comply with the law, when your data will be processed unlawfully or the data must be excluded;

• in relation to the examination of data analysis, when you have noticed that the data is incorrect - you can perform an analysis of your data to check the correctness of this data;
